

UNIFOR Local 76 Scholarship Program

Four (4) scholarships worth \$1000.00 each are made available each year to Local 76 members and children of local 76 members pursuing full time post secondary education at a recognized institution such as university, college, technical or trade school.

These scholarships are available to students who have completed their secondary school studies and who are entering post secondary studies at a university, college, technical or trade school. Although students may only receive one (1) scholarship they may apply during the following conditions and may apply more than one time if previously unsuccessful:

- Last year of secondary education

- Entering into any year of post secondary education other than their last year

The following applicants are eligible:

- Members of UNIFOR in good standing

- Children of members of UNIFOR in good standing

- Children of members of UNIFOR who passed away while in good standing

- Children of members of UNIFOR who retired in good standing

The selection of successful applicants will be made by a committee appointed by the President of Local 76 on behalf of the executive board. Selections made by the board will be final. If a direct family member of a committee member is an applicant the committee member will excuse himself/herself from the selection process.

Applicants will be required to complete the attached UNIFOR scholarship form along with a complete school record as well as an essay with a minimum of one thousand (1000) words on the topic: "What does the labour movement mean to me and my family" and submit it to UNIFOR, Local 76, 5814 Ash Avenue, Powell River, B.C. V8A 4R4 no later than May 05th, 2017.

The selection committee will announce their decision no later than June 06, 2017 at which time the successful candidates will be informed. Financial arrangements can then be finalized.
